No content GPA calculated for Elementary Education majors.
- 3) 3.00 Professional Education GPA: No grade lower than a "C" and no Incomplete "I"
- 4) Completion of Block I Prerequisite Courses (EDCI 205 and EDCI 285):
"C" or higher is required
- 5) Meet current licensure Praxis I test qualification scores:
