Accelerated Masters

- Provides a pathway for completing a masters in education faster
- Students begin Masters coursework while finishing their undergraduate degree

Board Certification in Behavior Analysis

- National certification in behavior analysis
Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA)
- The accelerated masters program provides required coursework for becoming a BCBA
- Students are eligible to sit for the Behavior Analysts certification exam after:
 - Coursework completion
 - Supervised filed hours completion

Masters in Education in Applied Behavior Analysis

- 36 credit hours
- Verified Course Sequence through Association for Behavior Analysis International
- Includes 2 semesters of practicum to allow students to accrue some of the required supervised hours with supervision from University and site supervisors

- ✓ Completed 90 undergraduate credit hours by the start of the program
- ✓ GPA of 3.25 or higher

ABA 4+1 Program Application Procedure

- Complete the Graduate School **Admission Application**
- Click ‘Create an account’; enter email address, name, and birthdate and click ‘Continue’
- On the application, for Campus, Major, Area of Interest, and Degree Objective:
 - Select a campus: WEST LAFAYETTE (MAIN CAMPUS)
 - Select your proposed graduate major: Educational Studies
 - Select an Area of Interest: Applied Behavior Analysis
 - Select a Delivery Option: On Campus
 - Select a Degree Objective: Master's of Science in Education

To complete an application file, the Office of Graduate Studies in the College of Education must receive the following in addition to the admissions application:

- An updated Purdue University **official transcript**
- Statement of Purpose
- Three letters of recommendation – one must be from an instructor in your undergraduate major
- The completed **Combined Degree Program Form (Form 27)** with student signature and Home Department Head signature
